**American Wheat Beer** Like most traditional Weizenbiers (wheat beers) of Germany, our wheat beer is brewed with almost 50% malted wheat, with the classic German hops to balance its soft, crisp malty flavor.



Slow, cool fermentation with a lager yeast gives our American Wheat the rich, smooth flavor characteristic of a Bavarian Weizen, along with the thirst-quenching, refreshing taste of a fine pilsner.

## **Munich-Style Lager**

Munich Helles (pale) is the maltiest and richest of all the German pale lagers.

Brewed with a generous portion of Munich malt and gently hopped, our lager is deep golden in color, smooth and full-bodied, with a pleasant malty aroma and rich malt flavor.



## **India Pale Ale**

This style of beer was originally brewed in England and transported by ship to India for the troops stationed there. The long voyage provided extra time for this hearty ale to condition in oak kegs, while large additions of hops helped to preserve it and provide a distinct hoppy character. Our India Pale Ale is a deep copper color, with an intense, spicy floral hop bouquet.



**Porter** This hearty English dark ale was popular with the porters and other workers in Nineteenth Century Great Britain. Brewed from eight malts, our classic London-style porter is opaque in color, with a dense foamy head and a rich bittersweet flavor. Because of the
